nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

The Kendriya Vidyalayas are run by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, an autonomous body formed by the Ministry of Education, (H.R.D.) Govt. of India, New Delhi, as a result of the recommendations of the Second Pay Commission. They primarily cater to the educational needs of the children of Central Govt. Employees including Defence Personnel and floating population liable to frequent transfers throughout the country. Needless to say, therefore, they have common syllabus and are affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

Every school, hence is a 'Miniature India' in itself and tries to inculcate in its students feelings of patriotism, brotherhood and national integration.

Place chosen for establishing Kendriya Vidyalayas are those having concentrations of Defence Personnel and other transferable Central Govt. Employees for admission. The Vidyalayas give priority to the children of transferable Defence Personnel, Central Govt. Employees and personnel of All India Service, but other floating population desirous of having such common pattern of education are also eligible for admission to the remaining seats. The instruction is imparted through the media of Hindi and English in these Vidyalayas, the ultimate object being to enable pupils to achieve a reasonable measure of proficiency in both the languages. The Vidyalayas prepare pupils for All India Secondary School Examination and Senior School Certificate Examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

The Vidyalayas are being developed as Quality Vidyalayas with some of the useful features of popular residential Vidyalaya; without making the schooling very expensive. The quality of teaching is kept reasonably high by an appropriate teacher-pupil ratio and provision of a suitable proportion of teachers with high qualifications.

The Kendriya Vidyalayas aim at having not only a common syllabus but also a well prepared syllabus and good text books based on that syllabus. They are intended to be equipped with good libraries, good laboratories and variety of other useful co-curricular activities.

The Vidyalayas impart free education upto Class VIII, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has already adopted the new pattern of School Education i.e. 10+2 pattern.

Long leave on any other ground shall not be allowed ordinarily except under very special circumstances and at the risk of the guardian himself / herself.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

No child is expected to be absent from school without a valid reason and a leave application from the guardian. If a child continues to be absent for 6 working days without any valid leave application, his / her name shall be struck off the rolls of the school for continued absence and he / she may be re-admitted to the school on payment of re-admission fee of Rs. 100/-. In case of absence due to sickness, a medical certificate from a registered practitioner should be submitted on the day of rejoining the school.
