भारत का संविधान उद्देशिका

हम, भारत के लोग, भारत को एक संपूर्ण प्रभुत्व-संपन्न, समाजवादी, पंथ-निरपेक्ष, लोकतंत्रात्मक गणराज्य बनाने के लिए तथा उसके समस्त नागरिकों को समाजिक, आर्थिक और राजनीतिक न्याय, विचार, अभिव्यक्ति, विश्वास, धर्म और उपसना की स्वतंत्रता, प्रतिष्ठा और अवसर की समता प्राप्त कराने के लिए, तथा उन सब में व्यक्ति की गरिमा और राष्ट्र की एकता और अखंडता सुनिश्चित करने वाली बंधुता बढ़ाने के लिए दृढ़ संकल्प होकर अपनी इस संविधान सभा में आज तारीख 26 नवंबर, 1949 ई. (मिति मार्गशीर्ष शुक्ल सादमी, संवत् द्रो हजार छह विक्रमी) को एतद्वारा इस संविधान को अंगीकृत, अधिनियमित और आत्मार्पित करते हैं।

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens: JUSTICE, social, economic and political; LIBERTY, of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship; EQUALITY, of status and of opportunity, and to promote among them all FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation: IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, DO HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

भारत का संविधान (भाग 4क)

नागरिकों के मूल कर्तव्य (अनुच्छेद 51क)

मूल कर्तव्य- भारत के प्रत्येक नागरिक का यह कर्तव्य होगा कि वह

- संविधान का पालन करे और उसके आदर्शों, संस्थाओं, राष्ट्रध्वज और राष्ट्रगान का आदर करे;
- स्वतंत्रता के लिए हमारे राष्ट्रीय आंदोलन को प्रेरित करने वाले उच्च आदर्शों का हृदय में साधारण रखे और उनका पालन करे;
- भारत की संप्रभुता, एकता और अखंडता की रक्षा करे और उसे अक्षुण्ण बनाए रखे;
- देश की रक्षा करे और आह्वान किए जाने पर राष्ट्र की सेवा करे;
- भारत के सभी लोगों में समरसता और समान भावना का निर्माण करे जो धर्म, भाषा और प्रदेश या वर्ण पर आधारित सभी भेदभावों से परे हो, ऐसी प्रथाओं का त्याग कर जो महिलाओं के सम्मान के विरुद्ध हो;
- हमारी सामाजिक संस्कृति की गौरवशाली परंपरा का महत्त्व समझे और उसका परिष्कार करे;
- प्राकृतिक पर्यावरण को, जिसके अंतर्गत वन, झील, नदी और वन्य जीव हैं, रक्षा करे और उसका संवर्धन करे तथा प्राणिमंत्र के प्रति दयाभाव रखे;
- वैज्ञानिक दृष्टिकोण, मानववाद और ज्ञानार्जन तथा सुधार की भावना का विकास करे;
- सार्वजनिक संपत्ति को सुरक्षित रखे और हिंसा से दूर रहे;
- व्यक्तिगत और सामूहिक गतिविधियों के सभी क्षेत्रों में उत्कर्ष की ओर बढ़ने का सतत प्रयास करे, जिससे राष्ट्र निरंतर बढ़ते हुए प्रयत्न और उपलब्धि की नई ऊँचाइयों को छू सके; और
- यदि माता-पिता या संरक्षक हैं, छह वर्ष से चौदह वर्ष तक की आयु वाले अपने, यथास्थिति, बालक या प्रतिभालय की शिक्षा के अवसर प्रदान करें।

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA (Chapter IV A)

Fundamental Duties - Article 51 A

Fundamental Duties - It shall be the duty of every citizen of India -

(a) to abide by the constitution and respect its ideas and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;

(b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;

(c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;

(d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;

(e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;

(f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;

(g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;

(h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;

(i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;

(j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the Nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Kendriya Vidyalayas are run by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, an autonomous body formed by the Ministry of Education, (H.R.D.) Govt. of India, New Delhi, as a result of the recommendations of the Second Pay Commission. They primarily cater to the educational needs of the children of Central Govt. Employees including Defence Personnel and floating population liable to frequent transfers throughout the country. Needless to say, therefore, they have common syllabus and are affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

Every school, hence is a 'Miniature India' in itself and tries to inculcate in its students feelings of patriotism, brotherhood and national integration.

Place chosen for establishing Kendriya Vidyalayas are those having concentrations of Defence Personnel and other transferable Central Govt. Employees for admission. The Vidyalayas give priority to the children of transferable Defence Personnel, Central Govt. Employees and personnel of All India Service, but other floating population desirous of having such common pattern of education are also eligible for admission to the remaining seats. The instruction is imparted through the media of Hindi and English in these Vidyalayas, the ultimate object being to enable pupils to achieve a reasonable measure of proficiency in both the languages. The Vidyalayas prepare pupils for All India Secondary School Examination and Senior School Certificate Examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

The Vidyalayas are being developed as Quality Vidyalayas with some of the useful features of popular residential Vidyalayas; without making the schooling very expensive. The quality of teaching is kept reasonably high by an appropriate teacher-pupil ratio and provision of a suitable proportion of teachers with high qualifications.

The Kendriya Vidyalayas aim at having not only a common syllabus but also a well prepared syllabus and good text books based on that syllabus. They are intended to be equipped with good libraries, good laboratories and variety of other useful co-curricular activities.

The Vidyalayas impart free education upto Class VIII. Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has already adopted the new pattern of School Education i.e. 10+2 pattern.

Exemption : (1) Girl students are exempted from depositing tuition fee. Students belonging to SC/ST community (as per records) are exempted from depositing tuition fee. (2) Parents belonging to Category I, II, III, IV and SC/ST, Single Girl child, who have reimbursement facilities for their ward (both girl and boy) at their parent/concerned Department will have to pay the Tuition Fees (IX-XII), Vidyalaya Vikash Nidhi Fund and Computer Fees to the Vidyalaya and the same can be claimed from their concerned Department under Children Education Allowance permissible.

Brother Concession : Where two more students of a parent are studying in class IX-XII, the boy in higher class will pay full tuition fees whereas the brother in lower class is exempted 50% of tuition fee subject to permission accorded by the Principal.

- (c) Single girl child need not pay VVN, Tuition fee and Computer Fund from class VI onwards.
- (d) Children of parents, who are living below poverty line, upto two children and having BPL card need not pay Tuition Fees and VVN contribution.

Admission: For admission guidelines, please refer to KVS website. Admission Fee 25.00

CONCESSION

If more than one child of the same parent (including dependent brothers and sisters) is a student of classes IX to XII of Kendriya Vidyalaya, the child in the higher class shall pay full tuition fee and the child in the lower class shall pay half of the tuition fee. If both the children are in the same class, the younger in age shall pay half and the elder full tuition fee. No fee of any kind is charged from single girl child of a parent.

A child may be allowed leave in a very special case by the Principal. The application should be sent to the school on the same day or latest by next day, duly signed by the father or guardian of the child. No half-day leave will be granted to the students unless there is any medical emergency. During Test and Examination, no leave will be allowed except on medical grounds and a Medical Certificate from an Authorised Medical Officer has to be submitted alongwith the leave application. Long leave on any other ground shall not be allowed ordinarily except under very special circumstances and at the risk of the guardian himself / herself.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

No child is expected to be absent from school without a valid reason and a leave application from the guardian. If a child continues to be absent for 6 working days without any valid leave application, his / her name shall be struck off the rolls of the school for continued absence and he / she may be re-admitted to the school on payment of re-admission fee of Rs. 100/-. In case of absence due to sickness, a medical certificate from a registered practitioner should be submitted on the day of rejoining the school.

SCHOOL LIBRARY AND READING ROOM

Each child is expected to make full use of the library and the reading room. He/She can borrow two books at a time for one week on his/her card. He/She may be allowed to have more than two books at a time on special recommendation of the Class Teacher.

Children shall observe the rules of the Library/Reading Room as enforced from time to time.

If a student fails to return the book loaned to him/her within the due date a fine at the rate of Rupee one per book per day from the date of return shall be levied in the case of wilful delays only.

They should keep the library card safe and take it back when returning the book. A second card shall be issued only on payment fine.

SCHEME OF STUDIES

The following is the scheme of studies in the Kendriya Vidyalayas.

- (a) For Class I to V : English, Hindi, Maths, Environmental Studies, Drawing, Music/CCA, Work Experience, Computer Lit., Library, Games/Yoga, and Art of Healthy and Productive living.
- (b) For class VI to VIII: English, Hindi, Maths, Social Science, G. Science, Sanskrit, Work Experience Health & physical Education, Computer lit., Games Yoga & Art.
- (c) For class IX & X : (under new scheme of 10+2) Hindi (Course-A), English (Course-A) Maths, Science & Technology, Social Science, Sanskrit, Work Experience, Health and Physical Education, Art & Computer Literacy.
- (d) For Class IX : Out of three languages subjects i.e. English, Hindi & Sanskrit, students have the option to keep any two languages.

RULES OF THE VIDYALAYA

- 1. On working days and at school functions children are expected to wear the uniform prescribed for the session. They must come to school neatly dressed, else they will be sent back and will be liable to disciplinary action.
- 2. Children are strictly forbidden to go out of the school during the school hours without permission from the Principal.
- 3. Books, note-books, bags, tiffin box etc. should bear the name and class of the owner. The school is not responsible for any such thing that gets lost.
- 4. Those who bring bicycles should keep them properly locked at the place fixed for them.
- 5. Once a student attends the school he/she will not be allowed any sort of leave. In case of emergency, the child will be escorted home by the parent with the written permission of the Principal.

- 6. Class monitors shall maintain the class discipline in the absence of the teacher. All students should co-operate with the monitor in maintaining the discipline of the class.
- 7. No student shall go out of the class without class-pass.
- 8. No student shall loiter in the Vidyalaya and disturb the teaching of the other classes. Free time is to be properly utilized in the Reading room and library.
- 9. Parents are requested to check the diaries of their children at least once a week and ensure that instructions are being followed by their wards properly.
- 10. Co-operate with the school in ensuring an effective education of your children. This can be done by
 - (i) Providing facilities of studies at home.
 - (ii) Providing Text books, note books and other requirements of your wards.
 - (iii) Assisting & guiding in doing home work.
 - (iv) Assisting your ward in removing his deficiency in particular subjects.
 - (v) Depositing fees as per rules.
 - (vi) Providing proper school uniform.
 - (vii) Assisting your ward in depositing Project Work in time.
- 11. See and countersign the remarks in the school calendar regularly.
- 12. Don't send your wards to the school when they are suffering from disease.
- 13. Ensure that your ward is escorted safely to school and back home.
- 14. See that your ward completes and deposits project work in time.
- 15. Should you feel or notice that your ward is not making the desired progress, kindly see the Principal (You are always welcome to the school to ensure the progress of your ward).
